



CILLDI 2010 CILLDI Bursary Application

The University of Alberta can support approximately 25 students to attend CILLDI in 2010 through a new CILLDI Bursary program. These bursaries are intended for students registered in two 3-credit courses (one in Block I and one in Block II), but they are not restricted to students in the Community Linguist Certificate (CLC) program or the Indigenous Language Instructor Certificate (ILIC) program. A CILLDI bursary will fully cover transportation to and from Edmonton; a meal plan and on-campus accommodation; and registration and tuition fees for full-time enrollment in two CILLDI courses during the 2010 Institute. Only a limited number of these annual bursaries are available, so take care to fill out this application form in full and submit it and accompanying documents (a letter of recommendation from a member of your community) to us by the March 1st deadline.
