- 1 award valued up to \$5000 for an academic year

conditions

- awarded to a U of A student to assist with the costs of participating on an academic year exchange to the University of Dundee in Scotland
- as a recipient of this award, you will be expected to participate in recruitment activities for this program
- as a recipient of this award you will be required to perform one or more of the following at the request of the Edmonton Burns Club:
 - a) tour of "Burns Country"
 - b) interview with recognized authority on Robert Burns
 - c) take a course related to Robert Burns
 - d) write and present a paper to the Edmonton Burns Club on your impressions of Scotland and the life and works of Robert Burns

eligibility

- U of A undergraduate student nominated to participate on the University of Dundee exchange during 2012 - 13 academic year with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA, and 2.7 GPA in the most recently completed term
- To apply you must have completed a minimum of *12 credits of post-secondary coursework by the application deadline (*15 credits if you are in the Faculty of Science)
- This award will be based on the following criteria:
 - 1) academic merit
 - 2) extra-curricular activities
 - 3) financial need
- Preference will be given to those students who demonstrate all of the above criteria, however, ALL students are still encouraged to apply

deadline

January 31, 2012

- Application Period: January 4 - 31, 2012. DO NOT submit application until your Fall term grades are posted on your transcript.
- Complete applications must be submitted with all supporting documents to the Education Abroad office. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

Note: Students will still be required to Meet with an Advisor by the appropriate deadline to obtain the Study Abroad Application form. See website for details.

application results

- Applicants will be notified if they have been nominated for an award
- Award recipients must confirm their acceptance of the award to the Education Abroad office. Failure to do so will result in the re-allocation of their award.
- The University of Alberta's fiscal year and award allocation runs from April 1 to March 31. The Office of Student Awards will confirm the number of awards and award value after the new fiscal year has begun.
