

# Edmonton Consular Ball Scholarship

for International Studies

## value

- Up to \$3000
- Up to 3 awards

## conditions

- To be awarded to U of A senior undergraduate or graduate students in any discipline to undertake a summer research project in international studies

## eligibility

- U of A undergraduate (3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year) or graduate students in any discipline to undertake a summer research project in international studies during the spring/summer term 2012
- Tenable to any country but subject to restriction by the U of A's policy on risk and liability management

## deadline

### January 31, 2012

- Application Period: January 4 - 31, 2012. DO NOT submit application until your Fall term grades are posted on your transcript.
- Complete applications must be submitted with all supporting documents to the Education Abroad Program. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

## application materials

**The application is in the form of a letter accompanied by the following documents:**

- Short proposal (2 pages max.) describing the topic the student wishes to study and how the student will benefit from this research. The study may focus on any aspect of the student's discipline.
- Short resume, which also provides the student's social insurance number, Faculty name, department, year of study, and major area of study
- Official transcripts of all completed post-secondary work at the U of A and other institutions are required

## application selection

- The Director, Education Abroad chairs a selection committee comprised of three Faculty members and two members of the Consular Corps
- The U of A committee members are drawn from Faculties and academic units
- The committee reviews the applications and selects two to three winners, depending on the award fund account

## application results

- Applicants are informed by letter shortly after the committee meeting whether or not they have been nominated for the award

## award presentation

- Award recipients are invited to the Ball (usually in May) to receive their award. For recipients unable to attend the Ball, the Education Abroad Program will arrange for the cheque to be given to them.
- At the conclusion of the study, the completed research project should be submitted to the Chair, Consular Ball Scholarship Committee for forwarding to the Consular Corps
