conditions

- To be awarded to U of A undergraduate or graduate students to assist with the costs of participating in a study program to Italy
- Recipients of this award will be expected to participate in recruitment activities for this program

eligibility

- U of A undergraduate and graduate students nominated to participate in a formal international program to Italy during the 2012 – 13 academic year (including summer 2012) with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and 2.7 GPA in the most recently completed term
- This award will be based on the following criteria:
 - 1) financial need
 - 2) academic merit
 - 3) extra-curricular
- Preference will be given to those students who demonstrate all of the above criteria, however, ALL students are still encouraged to apply
- Students enrolled in Italian language or studies will also get preference

- Application Period: January 4 - 31, 2012. **DO NOT** submit application until your Fall term grades are posted on your transcript.
- Complete applications must be submitted with all supporting documents to the Education Abroad Program office. **Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.**
